Salzburg is one of the most beautiful cities in the world and a wedding in Salzburg is a truly breathtaking experience. Thousands of couples from around the globe have taken advantage of the unique romantic flair of marrying in a city that combines history and culture with a stunning cityscape.

Salzburg offers bridal couples an exceptionally beautiful and exclusive location for a dream wedding, details of which are provided below.

The Marble Hall:

The magnificent Marble Staircase leading up to the Marble Hall in Mirabell Palace owes its existence to the love between Archbishop Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau and the commoner's daughter, Salome Alt. The archbishop's former ballroom, in which Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart once performed together with his father, Leopold, and sister, Maria Anna ("Nannerl"), is considered one of the most beautiful wedding halls in the world. Over 100,000 couples have walked up the staircase to tie the knot in the Marble Hall. The Mirabell Gardens, Marble Staircase, Pegasus Fountain and Hohensalzburg Fortress are the perfect backdrop for dream wedding photos in Salzburg. The Marble Hall can seat approx. 125 wedding guests.

Lepoldskron Palace:

The unparalleled location of the Rococo Leopoldskron Palace on the beautiful Leopoldskron Lake is a very special setting for a dream wedding. The palace was built between 1736 and 1740 under Prince Archbishop Leopold Anton Freiherr von Firmian. Max Reinhard, co-founder of the Salzburg Festival, was the best-known owner. The spacious lobby on the ground floor with a view of the picturesque terrace, pond and the Untersberg can accommodate approx. 100 people.

Fuschl Palace:

Fuschl Palace in the heart of the Salzkammergut Lake District was built in 1450 on one of the Fuschlsee peninsulas. It has housed nobility, archbishops, empresses and movie stars. During the 1950s the palace served as the location for the Sissi movies starring Romy Schneider. Civil ceremonies are held in the magnificent ballroom overlooking the Fuschlsee.

Mönchstein Palace

First documented in 1350, the Mönchstein was once referred to as the "Tettelheimer Tower." The mountain itself was named after the monks from the nearby Benedictine Monastery of St. Peter. Its panoramic location high above Salzburg puts the entire city at the feet of the bridal couple. Weddings are held in the Gothic Hall of the romantic Mönchstein Hotel, offering room for approx. 25 wedding guests.

Hohensalzburg Fortress:

Hohensalzburg towers high above the city and is Salzburg's landmark. Construction of a residential tower, a church and a residential building started in 1077 under Gebhard von Helfenstein; numerous successors added to the fortress, giving it today's appearance. The Salzburg Registry Office holds wedding ceremonies in the Fortress Ballroom. The Ballroom has a rustic charm and can accommodate approx. 150 wedding guests.

Hellbrunn Palace:

Prince Archbishop Markus Sittikus built Hellbrunn Palace and park as a pleasure palace just south of the city between 1615 and 1617. The palace was designed for celebrations. The spacious historic park, the trick fountains and the Renaissance palace, are the perfect venue for a dream wedding. Weddings at Hellbrunn Palace are held in the Carabinieri Hall, accommodating approx. 80 wedding guests.

The Cavalier House in Klessheim

The Cavalier House originally served as an aristocratic residence called the Kleshof. It was purchased by Archbishop Johann Ernest Graf Thun in 1690. Construction of the "Favorita" pleasure palace started around 1700 according to plans by Fischer von Erlach. The Registry Office's tip: a wedding fair called "Hochzeitswelt Salzburg" is held at the Cavalier House each year, giving bridal couples an opportunity to plan every detail of their big day.
